Recent Experience

Most recently, I spent seven years as a consultant at Stockholm Exergi. I worked on a suite of tools for analyzing and understanding large-scale energy data. My work covered both UX/UI and engineering. I led user explorations and ideations, crafted detailed roadmaps with clear user needs and outcomes, designed consistent interfaces across multiple products, improved data visualizations and analytic abilities, and helped ensure complex workflows felt clear and manageable.

On the engineering side, I led the transition to a modern, type-safe React architecture. I built and maintained the design system, component library, and frontend tooling used across all product teams. I also led the work in developing our guidelines for creating type safe APIs across our products, ensuring a more seamless integration between backend and frontend. I also supported onboarding, mentoring, and overall closer alignment between design and engineering.

As a long-term consultant for Stockholm Exergi Intelligy Solution Platform, I led initiatives spanning UX/UI design, frontend development and infrastructure. I helped transition multiple products from a Python/Django-based interface to a modern React architecture, and later focused on building scalable frontend systems – including design systems, shared libraries, developer tooling, and documentation – to improve consistency and efficiency across applications and teams.

I joined Stockholm Exergi as a UX/UI Designer for Intelligy Solutions – a platform used by property owners to monitor, control and analyze district energy usage, substation capacity, and indoor climate across single buildings or large property portfolios. My work centered on creating intuitive, data-driven interfaces to enhance usability and deliver clear, actionable information to users.

After my initial work in UX/UI design, I was contracted to contribute to frontend development. My responsibilities began with implementing a new GUI within the existing Python and Django stack. As the platform evolved, we transitioned to a single-page application architecture in React, establishing a clear separation between backend and frontend.

Over five years, I worked across multiple Intelligy Solutions products, primarily internal tools for managing installations and load balancing in district energy networks, with a focus on both UX/UI design and frontend development.



In recent years, I have concentrated on frontend infrastructure - designing and building design systems, component libraries, tooling for application configuration, API SDK generation, and shared libraries for formatting and translations, all maintained in a shared monorepo for consistency and efficiency across applications.

As the frontend team grew, I supported onboarding new developers and took the lead in creating comprehensive guidelines and documentation. This included not only Git workflows and commit strategies, but also API specification and design guidelines, deployment strategies, and best practices for working within our shared codebase. These efforts helped ensure consistency, clarity, and efficiency as the team and product portfolio expanded.

Contracted by Mighty Group to help architect and implement e-commerce solutions for Better Bodies and GASP. We built two global WooCommerce stores tailored for international markets and developed a custom integration framework connecting Microsoft Dynamics 365 with multiple e-commerce storefronts. This system enabled seamless synchronization of products, inventory, and pricing across currencies and platforms, ensuring data consistency and operational efficiency.

Additionally, we created a custom Product Information Management (PIM) tool to centralize product metadata for use across all storefronts. My work focused primarily on backend development using PHP, WordPress, WooCommerce, Laravel, Node.js, and Feathers.js.

At Printees, our founding mission was to simplify the process of printing high-quality organic t-shirts while maintaining a strong commitment to quality and sustainability. We prioritized eco-friendly practices, ensuring all products were free from harmful materials.

I contributed as a UX/UI Designer and Frontend Developer to build a custom website featuring an intuitive editor for designing personalized t-shirts, alongside a fully custom e-commerce platform. Additionally, we developed a supplier portal that allowed production partners to log in and track all orders assigned to them, streamlining the production workflow and delivery.

Beyond design and development, I was actively involved in business development, helping to shape the company's strategic direction, grow our customer base, and establish partnerships aligned with our values.

Travellink (part of FCM Group), a travel agency with a strong online presence and customer support focus, contracted me as a UX/UI Designer and Frontend Developer. Later in the assignment, I also contributed to the site for booking private travels.

My work focused on UI design and frontend development using Mustache templating, HTML, JavaScript, and jQuery. Additionally, I built tooling for compiling Sass using Grunt and Gulp, streamlining the frontend build process and optimizing application load times.

Contracted to lead the design and development of a new corporate website for Cygate, a leading Swedish IT company and part of Telia Company.

I managed the implementation process and led a team consisting of two developers and one designer to deliver a robust, user-friendly website. The site was built on WordPress with a custom server infrastructure hosted on iPeer, a hosting provider acquired by Cygate in 2014.

I founded Awkward Group together with a friend after our graduation from Stockholm University. We began our operation by offering digital design and production services to ad agencies. In 2013, our paths diverged, and I pivoted to working as a freelancer and consultant, specializing in digital product design and development.

Before pursuing my studies at Stockholm University, I founded a small agency called Stockholm Design & Form. During this time, I dedicated a significant portion of my spare time to assisting smaller clients with their branding, web design, and web development needs.
